Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy - meditate on these things." (Philippians 4:4-9)

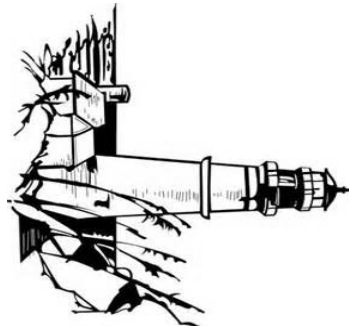
Absent-A list of those absent at Sunday worship is on the back table. Remember to check on them and let them know they are missed.
