Wedding Bells

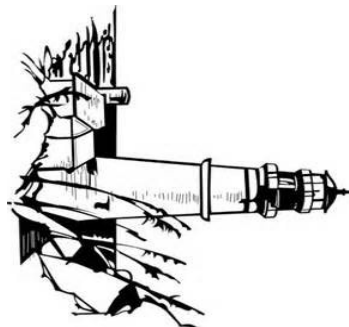
