One of the things I find interesting about this article is that I personally know Steve Stroud. We attended Freed-Hardeman College together and we played a good bit of basketball together. However, no longer is Steve and 18 year old boy, but a 42 year old man. This decision that Steve made was made in 1979, yet 24 years later, people all over the country are still reading about the courageous decision of this "youngster". The decision he made 24 years ago is still an example to people today and may embolden someone else to make the same choice.
